Purpose of the Job:

Ensure the security of the establishment, provide a cleaning and general maintenance service of internal and externally buildings and surrounding areas. Specific duties will vary according to the establishment.

Main duties and responsibilities:

- Liaise with the Registered Manager on priorities of maintenance, cleaning and improvement work to ensure the work is carried out in order of priority.
- Maintain security on site and deal with any problems and attend to all contractors working site to ensure a safe environment.
- Undertake daily and seasonal maintenance of the site and equipment, inside and out, as required for the type of establishment.
- To maintain landscaping of external areas to include grass mowing, pruning and other aspects of gardening as required.
- To ensure outside areas are kept tidy by removing litter, sweeping leaves and emptying bins etc.
- Ensure rooms are set up appropriately for each group/user and dismantled after use.
- Maintain adequate supplies of cleaning materials and supplies. Re-ordering when needed to meet the establishments needs.
- To implement and monitor all Health and Safety at work requirements and any relevant legislation.
- Attend training courses as required.
- Manage all routing and safety checks around the site.
- To oversee the annual testing of electrical portable appliances in the Short Break Unit
- To undertake any reasonable duties as may be required by the Registered Manager.
