Purpose of the Job:

The Road Safety Team's purpose in line with The Vision Zero policy, is to contribute to road casualty reduction and thereby improve quality of life in Kent. This role supports the Team's purpose through delivering practical driver assessment as required.

Main duties and responsibilities:

- To deliver pre-set driver assessment programmes, in order to contribute to casualty reduction.
- Carry out driver assessment to the standard set by the supervisor, i.e. Driving Standards Agency test standards.
- Support the development and dissemination of road safety messages to drivers.
- Support the evaluation of educational inputs when required.
- Create and maintain an effective and focused learning environment.
- Take responsibility to deal with complex questions, related to appropriate programmes, to facilitate client learning.
- Influence the road user attitude and behaviour of drivers through raising their awareness, increasing their knowledge and affecting their intended behaviour.
- Liaise with organisations to arrange to meet additional training needs, as agreed with the supervisor
- Promote other driver training and assessment services to organisations as appropriate.
- Collect and drive appropriate vehicles to the training site if required, including minibus.
- Identify and manage risks to health and safety (colleagues, staff and children) in the teaching environment, using existing risk assessments if applicable.
- Ensure assessments are delivered in line with Kent County Council's health and safety policy with an awareness of accident and incident reporting procedures.
