Purpose of the Job:

Work as part of a team with the aim of providing a 24 hour quality service to users. The postholder will be part of a Care Centre Team working with minimum supervision to provide a complete range of enabling and personal care for clients requiring intense recuperative care within a residential establishment.

Main duties and responsibilities:

- Supervise and assist service users with personal care to ensure the provision of physical and emotional care, enabling independence where possible in all aspects of individual rehabilitative care plans whilst maintaining client privacy and dignity.
- Ensure that all records, such as daily contact sheets and reviews are properly maintained to ensure that the care given meets the agreed care plans, notifying the appropriate lead professionals of any changes and matters of concern.
- Assist in the preparation and updating of night care plans, and ensure all colleagues are advised of any developments during the night shift.
- Distribute and supervise the distribution of medication, ensuring that the distribution is properly recorded, as prescribed and authorised by the lead professional in accordance with received training, agreed procedures and practice, i.e. KCC's Medication Policy, and the client care programme.
- Provide the Centre Manager with any information or issues requiring intervention by other agencies or other sections of the directorate, to ensure matters are dealt with appropriately.
- Ensure care practice promotes equalities which recognises and encourages anti discriminatory behaviour, respecting confidentiality of information, recognition of client rights and choice and respect of personal beliefs.
