## Purpose of the Job:

To work with children in care, families, carers, schools, and agencies to promote regular school attendance.

To support and contribute to raising the educational attainment of and improve outcomes for, children in care.

## Main duties and responsibilities:

- Liaise between the Local Authority, other local authorities, districts, schools, parents/carers and pupils to ensure regular attendance of all children in care in school or alternative education provision.
- Contribute as a member of Virtual School Kent to improving attendance, educational attainment and outcomes for Kent's children in care in line with Every Child Matters, Children and Young Persons Plan and the Kent Pledge.
- Provide support and guidance to foster carers/parents to identify and address reasons for nonattendance.
- Appraise parents/carers of procedures/facilities available to them and their children through the Local Authority and other agencies to support regular attendance.
- Monitor and evaluate attendance data to inform service delivery and contribute to regular reporting of children in care attendance in line with national and local authority targets.
- Support schools and alternative education providers with policies, procedures, and strategies for improving attendance.
- Promote the safeguarding of children and young people and represent the local authority at meetings and case conferences when required.
- Participate in training and other learning activities as required and attend relevant meeting to ensure own continuing professional development.
