This is a **level 2** apprenticeship in the Discovery Day Nursery within the Kent Early Years and Childcare Service which is part of The Education People

- Provide inclusive play and learning opportunities for all children attending the setting with an emphasis on the characteristics of effective teaching and learning.

- Contribute to children's observations of learning, planning and assessment and maintain children's' learning records.
- Understand and begin to develop effective working relationships with all parents, families and practitioners within the setting and contribute to a culture of self-evaluation.

- Play and active role in supporting children's health and well-being to foster a culture of risk taking in a safe and secure environment.
- Contribute to the 'life' of the nursery and participate in wider activities, such as open days and parents' meetings
